

## Museum Passes

The Peninsula Public Library offers a variety of passes to local museums for use by our patrons.

Museum passes may be reserved for the current or following month, subject to availability, and

must be handled by an adult (18 years or older). One pass may be borrowed a maximum of once

every thirty days per family.

Reserves are taken at the Reference Desk and/or by phone or email.

The Library reserves the right to monitor usage to ensure fair access for the greatest number of

patrons.

The Library currently offers two types of passes:

### **Print on Demand**

Passes are for one day only; the date of the patron's visit is pre-printed on the pass.

These passes can be picked up at the Library, or emailed to the patron, and do not have to be returned.

There are no late fees or fines associated with Print on Demand passes.

### **Pick up/drop off**

Pass may be borrowed for 4 days and must be returned to the Library no later than an

hour before closing on the due date.

Pass may not be returned in the book drop.

If overdue, late fee is \$5.00 per day.

In the event that non-return of a museum pass necessitates the Library to pay the

entrance fee for the next user, that entry fee will be attached to the delinquent borrower's

record.

A non-refundable fee of \$25.00 will be charged if a pass is lost.

### **Library passes frequently are not valid for entrance to museum special events and**

**fundraisers.** It is the responsibility of the user to telephone or check the Museum website in

advance for information on hours of operation, parking and/or directions.
